What is OneSpace?

OneSpace is UMO's secure digital passport for mental health, neurodiversity, disability and wellbeing. It is built to support students and graduates during crucial transitions.



It allows students and graduates to record needs, strengths and ways of working in one place, with safe sharing for universities, placements and employers.

Designed to support transitions into placements, internships and graduate employment, OneSpace helps students communicate adjustments clearly and reduce repeated disclosure.

Aligned with UK Government Adjustment Passport principles (DWP, 2024)



What Does The Passport Contain?

1. Structured Adjustment Profile

- ▶ Support needs and working preferences in one place.
- ▶ Share before interviews, placements or starting a new role.

2. Strengths & Placement Planning

- ▶ Strengths and communication preferences.
- ▶ Prepare for new teams, supervisors and professional expectations.

3. Secure Document Vault

- ▶ Encrypted storage for evidence and support letters.
- ▶ Bring to occupational health or Access to Work conversations.

Strengthening Student Transitions

Structured transition support for graduates moving from university to the workplace.

Why This Matters

Placements, internships and graduate roles introduce new expectations and environments. Preparation helps students communicate support needs and adapt to professional settings.

Impact

- ▶ Reduces repeated disclosure
- ▶ Supports confident conversations with supervisors and employers
- ▶ Improves coordination between university and workplace
- ▶ Strengthens safety and wellbeing for students and graduates

How Students Use The Passport

Students and graduates use their Passport to communicate clearly and confidently as they move into professional environments.

- ▶ Share a structured profile before starting a placement or internship
- ▶ Prepare for supervision meetings or performance reviews
- ▶ Explain adjustments during interviews or graduate schemes
- ▶ Store evidence and documents securely
- ▶ Use one consistent Passport from university to employment

A practical, portable way to communicate needs quickly and safely in professional environments.



Start with a Funded Pilot

We offer a funded 3-month pilot to support students during key transitions. Test structured transition support before full rollout.

What the Pilot Includes:

- ▶ Access for transition cohorts (placements, final-year or graduates)
- ▶ Induction and transition use cases
- ▶ Engagement and activation analytics
- ▶ Short impact summary focused on transition success
